ABOUT THE DUFFERIN-PEEL EXTENDED FRENCH APPLICATION & REGISTRATION PROCESS



Students applying to Grade 5 Extended French must:

□ be entering Grade 5 in the 2020-2021 school year

□ have proof of Baptism (in the Roman Catholic Church or in an Eastern Church in full communion with the Holy See of Rome) OR parent/guardian has proof of Baptism (in the Roman Catholic Church or in an Eastern Church in full communion with the Holy See of Rome)



All Extended French schools have a boundary and designated feeder schools.

A RANDOM SELECTION may be required at an Extended French School.



February 20 - 27, 2020

A random selection process will <u>only</u> be held if the number of applications exceeds the places available for one class(27) or two classes (54) where approved.

The random selection process, if needed, will take place between February 20, 2020 and February 27, 2020 at a time determined by the principal.

The results will be communicated in the days following the random selection.

**The deadline to accept or decline an Extended French placement is March 6, 2020.



Transportation is provided to eligible Extended French students.



Transportation is provided to eligible Extended French students who live more than 2 kilometers away from the Extended French school location.
